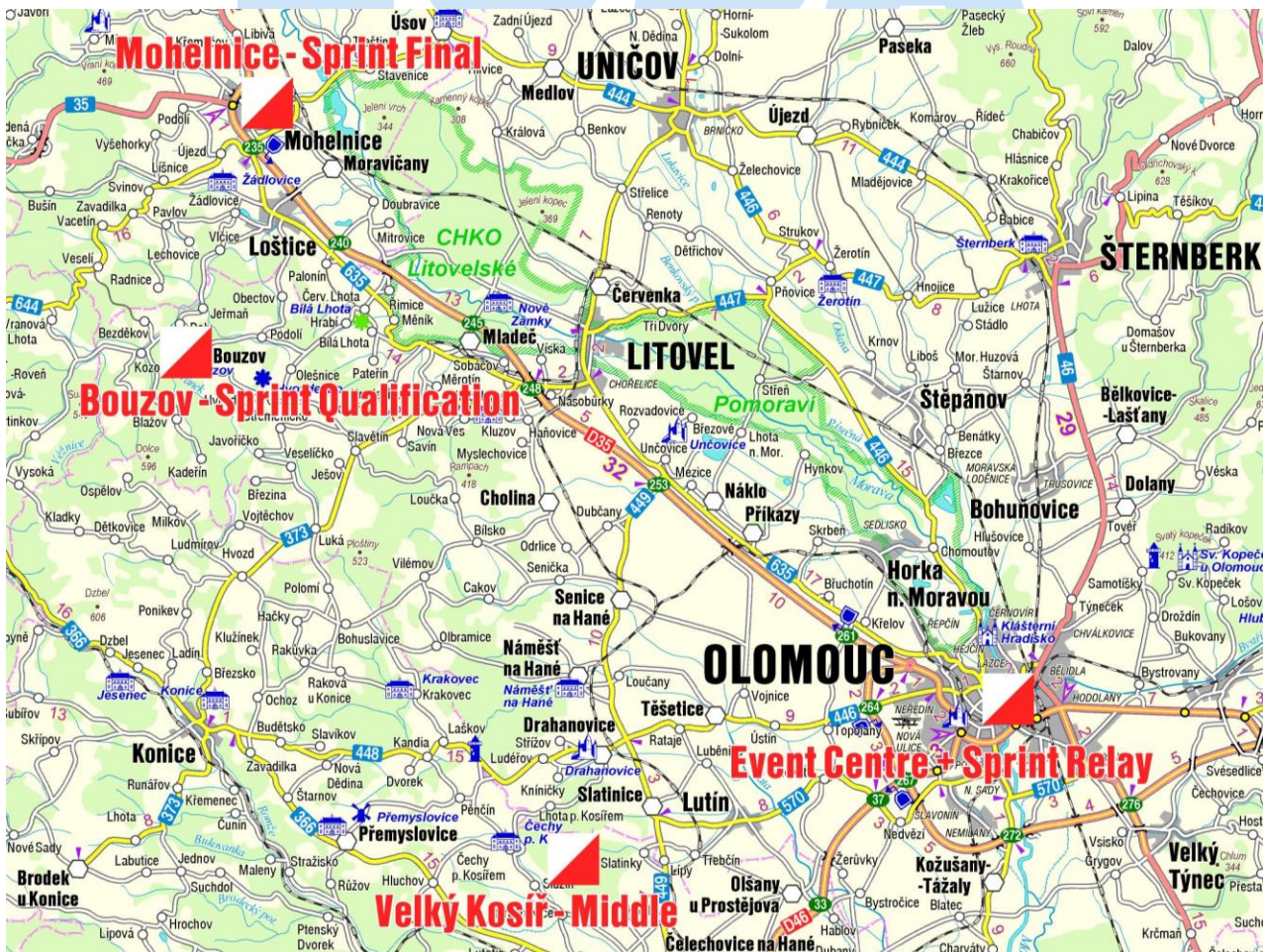

## Classes

### **Individual competitions:**

Women Sprint, Middle Distance

Men Sprint, Middle Distance

Winning times (for both classes): Sprint Qualification and Final: 12 – 15 minutes,

Middle Distance: 35 – 40 minutes

### **Sprint Relay Competition**

Men/Men MM sprint relay

Women/Women WW sprint relay

Men/Women MW sprint relay

**Two runners in one team. Both members of the team run twice. One person can only run in one relay team.**

Winning times (per leg) 12 – 15 minutes.

### **Overall Universities Competition**

will be counted from individual and relay competitions.

### **Special Regulations for Sprint Competition (Qualification and Final)**

Number of qualification heats depends on number of participants in each class:

|                       |         |                        |         |
|-----------------------|---------|------------------------|---------|
| 1 - 60 participants   | 1 heat  | 121 - 180 participants | 3 heats |
| 61 - 120 participants | 2 heats | 181 and more           | 4 heats |

Each final has 60 competitors (A/B/C), D has all the rest

- if 1 qualification heat: everyone qualifies for the "A"-final

- if 2 qualification heats: places 1-30 qualify for the "A"-final, others to "B"-final

- if 3 qualification heats: places 1-20 qualify for the "A"-final, etc.

## Punching System and Time-keeping

SportIdent Air+ system will be used. Competitors can use their own SI Air+ card. For competitors without their own SI Air+ card, it will be possible to rent one without charge.

Via online EUSA entry system – will be available from 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018

## Entry deadlines

General entry: **January 15th 2019**

Quantitative entry: **April 15th 2019**

Individual entry: **June 15th 2019**

## Entry Fee

65 EUR per person per day, 30 EUR EUSA entry fee per person per event  
in total: 5 days x 65 EUR = **325 EUR + 30 EUR = 355 EUR**

The total entry fee includes:

- entry for all competitions
- accommodation - double/twin and single rooms in student dormitory
- meal 3 times per day (from Tuesday's dinner to Sunday's breakfast)
- transport to all competitions and trainings
- transport from/to the official airport/railway station
- official T-shirt or similar present

## Transport

Official train station - Olomouc hlavní nádraží (Olomouc Main Station)

Official international airport – Praha (PRG) <https://www.prg.aero/en/>

Transport from the other nearby airports – Vienna (VIE), Bratislava (BTS), Katowice (KTW) can be organized on request and with extra payment.

## Eligibility

Participants (according to the EUSA Rules and Regulations)

- have to be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a University or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority or their country, or former students who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in 2018;
- must be at least 17 and less than 30 years of age on January 1st, 2019 (date of birth must be between January 1st, 1989 and December 31st, 2001);

Minimum number of participants from any University or similar institute is 2 (two) competitors. There is no restriction on the maximum number of competitors which can be entered by any University or similar institute.

## Terrain

Sprint Qualification – hilly terrain, partly urban area, partly park/forest

Sprint Final – undulating terrain, urban area

Middle Distance competition + Forest Model – medium hilly terrain, mixed forest, average number of paths

Sprint Relay competition + Sprint Model – flat terrain, partly urban area, partly park
