Entries

Entries – entries only via EUSA online information system

Updated deadlines:

GENERAL ENTRY 15 April 2019* + deposit payment 200 EUR per university

(* - athletes capacity of the race are not full and due to is still possible to enter to the event. Quick guide you can find in Appendix No.1)

QUANTITATIVE ENTRY 15 May 2019 + 50% payment of total sum for all entered participants

INDIVIDUAL ENTRY 15 June 2019 + rest of payment

Notes:

- EUSA Executive Committee approved change for minimum number of runners. Minimum 1 (one) athlete from each University or similar institute is allowed to take part in the event.
- together 160 athlete from 36 universities entered to the event before the general entry deadline. You can check the list of participating universities in Appendix No.2.

Entry Fee

65 EUR per person per day, 30 EUR EUSA entry fee per person per event
in total: 5 days x 65 EUR = **325 EUR + 30 EUR = 355 EUR**

The total entry fee includes:

- entry for all competitions
- accommodation - double/twin and single rooms in student dormitory
- meal 3 times per day (from Tuesday's dinner to Sunday's breakfast)
- transport to all competitions and trainings
- transport from/to the official airport/railway station
- official T-shirt or similar present

Terrain

Sprint Qualification + Sprint Model – hilly terrain, partly urban area, partly park/forest

Sprint Final + Sprint Model (Prolog) – undulating terrain, urban area

Middle Distance competition + Forest Model – medium hilly terrain, mixed forest, average number of paths

Sprint Relay competition – flat terrain, partly urban area, partly park

ALLOWED: to visit as a student or tourist, to run without a map

„HARD EMBARGO“ in all forest areas: no entry.

Only official University clothes will be allowed. It is forbidden to run in national team or club suite. If the university have no official suite, it will be possible to run in the “neutral” suite which each participants will receive from the organizers during the registration.
